As a result of plant closures at Tampere and Petikko, the remaining site in Vantaa must double in capacity, while adopting best practice in terms of health and safety. Total Logistics developed a highly automated plant design that reduces the need for heavy lifting.

One of the largest food companies in the Baltic Sea region, HK Ruokatalo processes fresh meat, poultry and convenience foods and is the market-leading retailer of processed meats in the region. Consultants from Total Logistics have been involved in helping the HK management team to develop a complete strategic design specification for the new plant, as well as offering advice on key supplier selection.

It is expected that live operation of the renewed distribution centre at Vantaa will commence in January 2008.
